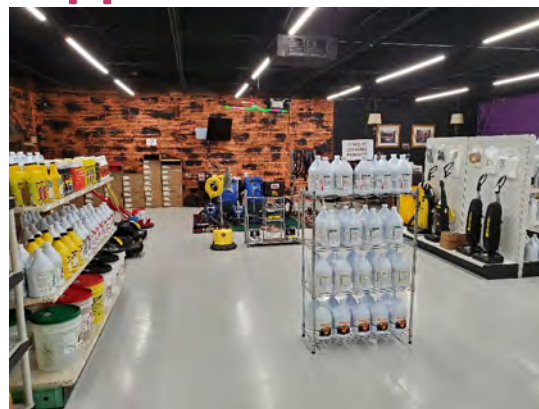

Hospital grade disinfectants, bathroom cleaners, floor strippers and finishes, mops and brooms, buckets and wringers, vacuum cleaners, buffing machines, buffing pads and even carpet cleaning machines are now available for purchase from our store.



Do you have a vacuum or pressure washer that needs to be repaired? Our service and repair department can take care of that for you too! Be sure to stop by and talk to Luis, our service and repair manager, about any repair work you may need on your equipment. He is an expert in small equipment repair, and he will have you up and running in no time.

In addition to providing an additional stream of revenue to the mission our cleaning store provides us with the opportunity to both train and hire our mission residents. Luis is an excellent example of one of our residents, who given the opportunity and training has excelled and is now a full-time employee of the mission. ## Exciting Road Ahead

By the time you read this, we will be well on the way toward an exciting change for the Mission in many ways. We have already accepted bids for the demolition of the two old buildings on the east side of the driveway and we have structural plans for the new buildings that will replace them.

Why are we doing all of this? The true reason is that COVID has taught us that we need to make changes in order to be more effective in dealing with the needs of the homeless. For those who don't desire to stay on campus with us, the first building will provide them with three meals a day and a safe place to sleep during inclement weather and cold nights.

The second building will provide several things that can make our services more streamlined and efficient. There will be a new larger kitchen facility, a new dining room, an auditorium, offices, conference room, restrooms, and a reception area.

In addition to the new buildings near the street, we can re-purpose the current dining room and kitchen. Most missions have a day room so that residents don't just "hang out" or sleep in the dorm; therefore, we will convert the dining room into a comfortable area for reading, board games, and entertainment space which will be open until 9:00 pm. The old kitchen area can then be designed and used as a laundry for the residents.
