An open letter from our Executive Director, Henry Young

What can we expect in 2023?

This could be an exceptionally good or a bad year for all of us. There is no clear determination for the economy, business expansion, supply chain increases, or other sectors of our lives. This is the honest assessment of our future this year: however; we must press on trusting that God will provide for all our needs.

In 1998, the monthly budget was \$17,000. This year it will be \$59,000 per month. That is an increase of 347% in twenty-five years and we are beginning our 51st year in operation. We are extremely grateful to our community for your continued support.

Our expectations for this year include helping more people in all areas of their lives. This includes areas such as spiritual health, drug and alcohol addiction, job training skills, case management, budget training, and working with other agencies for mental health issues. An example of the benefits of our program, half of our paid staff are currently or formerly guests at the mission facility.

To conclude this short letter, please continue to help us with monetary and in-kind donations. We can take any items that are in good working condition. These are sold to provide for expenses or used directly for the benefit of our guests. May God bless all who help us in efforts to provide for the homeless, and please tell others about the Las Cruces Gospel Rescue Mission. You might also consider us for estate planning.
