This year has had many changes in prices from day to day. Fuel costs sometimes fluctuate from day to day. Food costs are up with no relief in sight. You understand the point of what has happened this year. The good thing is that God has provided for the Mission throughout this uncertain year. We have been able to make the needed repairs that occur frequently, we have seen progress on the building project, and have been offered a piece of property that would enhance our ministry to the homeless population.

I know that this has not been a great year for many people, but I have seen that the needs of many have been accomplished despite trying times. These last two months of the year are always important for our financial well-being. Please consider making a larger contribution now than ever before. We need funds for daily expenses, for the completion of the building project (\$300,000 to 500,000) and help with the property that has been offered. Construction Update

As we near the end of the year, I thought it would be good to let you know where we stand on the new buildings.

About three weeks ago, we were nearing the end of the spendable money for the project. We asked the contractor to stop after he finished the phase for which we have paid. He was able to get another job out of town and is already to do a large job there. The story gets even better, as we have been getting some good donations lately that are allowing us to have one of the sub contractors finish their part of the inside. The way it looks on the inside of the larger building is as follows: the large refrigerator and freezer are completely done; the rough in plumbing is finished in the studs; the electrical wiring is being done as we speak; almost all of the studs are done except for the front offices, and then we will be ready for some formal inspections.
