This leadership along with a few other dedicated staff helps people every day "Move Forward" to a better life. Promotion and training from within allowed us to leverage decades of experience, and achieve better stewardship for our financial donors.

In the last few months, the Mission has implemented improved Care Management for guests which has produced several guests coming to know Jesus as their Savior, getting jobs, and acquiring better living arrangements for their medical needs. Also, the Mission offering overnight "Cold Weather Sheltering" has resulted in several people off the street deciding to stay longer and join the Shelter Program.

The Mission continues to partner with many churches, organizations, and individuals. This includes Chapel speakers/musicians, Burrell College student volunteers, Celebrate Recovery, Clothing Barn (Crosstown/LCGRM Partnership), and Care Bag partners outreaching streets of Las Cruces, etc.

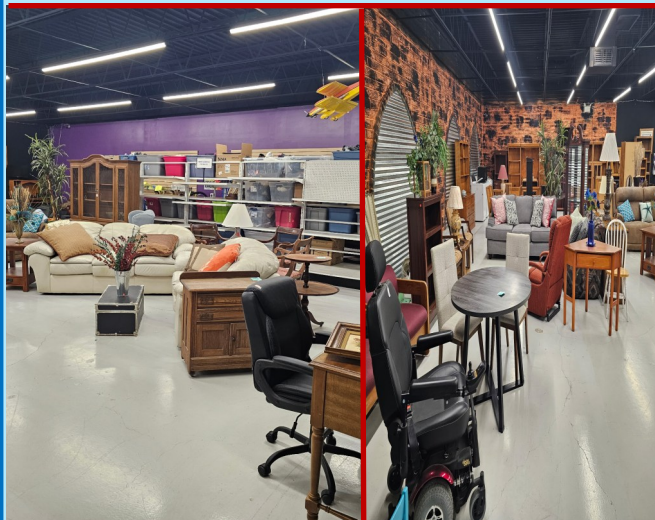
New America High School volunteers at the Las Cruces Gospel Rescue Mission
